Madeleine L'Engle Fun Facts at Ashley Hall

- 1935-1937 Madeleine L'Engle Camp was the Editor-in-Chief of *The Cerberus*, Ashley Hall's literary magazine.
- Madeleine graduated in 1937 and so did Martha "Chicky" Pierce, sister to Former First Lady Barbara Pierce Bush. Chicky and Madeline both went to Smith College.
- In 1936 Madeleine was the Junior Class President and also on the Student Council Board.
- For the 1937 senior statistics, Madeleine Camp was voted "Most Original."
- In her senior will, Madeleine "leaves her masks to Nancy Lawson in order that they may help her give the new girls a fitting and dignified welcome."
- She was President of the Student Council Board and House her senior year.
- In *The Cerberus*, they have a list of all of the seniors names and write what they were "Known for," "Admired for," "Main Occupation," "Ambition," and "Likely to"
 - Madeleine Camp was known for "Chemical fantasy"
 - Madeleine Camp was admired for "Literary ability"
 - Her main occupation was "Falling down"
 - Her ambition was "To stand on two feet"
 - Madeleine Camp was likely to "Be first woman pres."
