PAYMENT OPTIONS

Parents agree to pay the tuition & fees pertaining to the grade in which their child enrolled as follows:

Enrollment Deposit: All enrolling families, new and returning, are required to pay an enrollment deposit on submission of their online contract. This deposit is non-refundable and is deducted from the total cost of tuition & fees for the 2019-2020 school year. The enrollment deposit is \$2,000 per student, or 10% of total tuition & fees for families receiving financial assistance. (For international boarding students, the enrollment deposit is \$8,600 per student.)

New Student Registration Fee: For all new students, a one-time registration fee of \$1,500 per student is due by June 1, 2019, not to exceed \$3,000 per family in any one year. (For international boarding students, the registration fee is \$5,500 per student.)

Three Payment Options: Ashley Hall requires families to choose one of the plans listed below for the payment of tuition & fees through Smart Tuition, the online payment portal. Smart Tuition accepts payment by credit card, electronic check, or paper check.

- **100% Option:** Under this plan, the full payment of tuition & fees is due by June 1, 2019.
- **60/40 Option:** A payment of 60% of tuition & fees by June 1, 2019 and the remaining balance by November 1, 2019.
- **10-Month Option:** Ten monthly payments of tuition & fees from May 1, 2019 through February 1, 2020.

Please note: There is a late charge if payments are not paid according to the payment option chosen. Payments by credit card incur a convenience fee of 2.85%.

TUITION & FEES REFUND PLAN (TUITION INSURANCE)

- The Tuition & Fees Refund Plan is not required for any EEC student, new or returning.
- The Tuition & Fees Refund Plan is required for all new students who select the 60/40 or the 10-month payment plan.
- The Tuition & Fees Refund Plan is required for all returning families who select the 10-month payment plan.
- The Tuition & Fees Refund Plan is required for all students on any form of probation: financial, academic, or behavioral.
- The cost of The Tuition Refund Plan is 2.5% of the total annual tuition & fees.
- The Tuition Refund Plan, if purchased, will be billed separately through Smart Tuition.

If a child withdraws, the Tuition & Fees Refund Plan will pay benefits (subject to its terms, conditions, and limitations) to your account, which will provide substantial assistance in meeting your financial obligation. Remaining benefits not required to meet your obligation to the School will be refunded to you.

Refunds are only made for the following circumstances

Medical absence or withdrawal:

- 100% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated), provided physical disability extends for thirty-one or more consecutive days. Refunds are then made retroactive to the first day of disability. This is for any physical disability certified and treated by a legally qualified physician or surgeon.
- 60% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated), if disability is a mental or nervous disorder and extends for thirty-one or more consecutive days. Refunds are then made retroactive to the first day of disability. This disability must be certified and treated by a legally qualified psychiatrist, physician, or surgeon.
- 100% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated for every day lost) when epidemic closure is ordered by the local Public Health Authority.

Non-Medical Withdrawal:

- 60% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated) provided the student has attended more than the first fourteen consecutive school days of the academic year.

Dismissal:

- 75% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated) provided the student has attended more than the first fourteen consecutive school days of the academic year.
