FEE DETAILS

Enrollment Deposit: All enrolling families are required to pay an enrollment deposit on submission of their online contract. This non-refundable deposit is 10% of boarding program fees and is deducted from the total cost.

Tuition & Fees Refund Plan (Tuition Insurance)

- The Tuition & Fees Refund Plan is required for all new and returning students who select the two-payment or the ten-month payment option.
- The Tuition & Fees Refund Plan is required for all returning families who select the ten-month payment option.
- The Tuition & Fees Refund Plan is required for all students on any form of probation: financial, academic, or behavioral.
- The cost of the Tuition Refund Plan is 2.5% of the total annual tuition.
- The Tuition Refund Plan, if purchased, will be billed separately through Smart Tuition.

If a child withdraws, the Tuition & Fees Refund Plan will pay benefits (subject to its terms, conditions, and limitations) to your account, which will provide substantial assistance in meeting your financial obligation. Remaining benefits not required to meet your obligation to the School will be refunded to you.

**THE ASHLEY HALL BARBARA PIERCE BUSH '43 SCHOLARSHIP
FOR INTERNATIONAL BOARDING PROGRAM STUDENTS**

Ashley Hall is pleased to offer the Barbara Pierce Bush '43 Scholarship for International Boarding Program students for the 2022- 2023 academic year. Students who are accepted into Ashley Hall's International Boarding Program beginning with the 2022-2023 academic year are automatically considered for the award; there is no separate application process beyond the general application requirements for admission into the School and the International Boarding Program.

The Barbara Pierce Bush '43 Scholarship for International Boarding Program students is awarded based on a student's record of academic excellence and commitment to extracurricular endeavors as demonstrated in the student's application information, test scores, transcripts, teacher recommendations, and interviews. The maximum award per year is \$7,500, and the total maximum cumulative award per student is \$30,000.

Refunds are only made for the following circumstances

Medical absence or withdrawal:

- 100% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated), provided physical disability extends for thirty-one or more consecutive days. Refunds are then made retroactive to the first day of disability. This is for any physical disability certified and treated by a legally qualified physician or surgeon.
- 60% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated), if disability is a mental or nervous disorder and extends for thirty-one or more consecutive days. Refunds are then made retroactive to the first day of disability. This disability must be certified and treated by a legally qualified psychiatrist, physician, or surgeon.
- 100% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated for every day lost) when epidemic closure is ordered by the local Public Health Authority and no educational services are being provided on campus or via distance learning.

Non-Medical Withdrawal:

- 60% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated) provided the student has attended more than the first fourteen consecutive school days of the academic year.

Dismissal:

- 75% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated) provided the student has attended more than the first fourteen consecutive school days of the academic year.

Methods of Payment: Ashley Hall requires international families to choose one of the payment methods listed below for the payment of tuition & fees:

1) Bank wire transfer (details available upon request)

2) Through Smart Tuition, an online payment portal. Smart Tuition accepts payment by credit card or electronic check (*credit card payments incur a convenience fee of 2.85%.*)

- **100% Option:** Under this plan, the full payment of tuition & fees is due by June 1, 2022.
- **Two-Payment Option:** A payment of 50% of tuition & fees by June 1, 2022 and the remaining balance by November 1, 2022.
- **Ten-Month Option:** Ten monthly payments of tuition & fees from May 1, 2022 through February 1, 2023.

Please note: There is a late charge if payments are not paid according to the payment option chosen.
