#### **CARNIVAL ACTIVITIES**

There will be 12 Upper School student-run booths, and two jump castles, (one for Early School students, and one for Lower School). Bags will be provided for students to carry their booth prizes. The afternoon will also feature karaoke, and of course, Mystery Treats!

#### SCHOOL-DAY SCHEDULE AND CARNIVAL ATTENDANCE

Children in the Early School and students in grades K-2 must be signed out of their classroom by an adult AND accompanied by a parent or guardian for the duration of the Halloween Carnival. Guardians are asked not to arrive before noon. Extended Day will not be offered after the carnival.

# FRIDAY, OCTOBER 27 IS A FULL SCHOOL DAY FOR LOWER SCHOOL THROUGH UPPER SCHOOL STUDENTS

Lunch will be served for all grades. Upper School students each work a 30-minute shift during the Carnival, and proceeds go to these grade levels. Because this is considered a full day of school for these divisions, students are asked to remain on campus until the end of the Carnival, and carpool will run from 2:45 - 3:15 p.m.

#### HALLOWEEN COSTUME GUIDELINES

#### TICKETS FOR STUDENTS IN EARLY SCHOOL THROUGH SIXTH GRADE

Registration allows students access to ALL booths and events with the exception of food and raffle tickets. The cost is \$15 per student with a family cap of \$45. Upper School students, adults and children under 2 attend for free. Registration is on an honor system and will be available online through Thursday, October 26. Burger sliders, soft pretzels, chips, apple slices with caramel dipping sauce, Coke/Diet Coke and lemonade will be offered for \$1 each, and Sunny Daze Ice Cream truck will be on campus selling assorted ice cream for \$3 - \$6. In addition, there will be water stations available.
