PAYMENT OPTIONS

Parents/guardians agree to pay the tuition pertaining to the grade in which they are enrolling their student as follows:

Enrollment Deposit: All enrolling families, new and returning, are required to pay an enrollment deposit on submission of their online contract. This deposit is non-refundable and is deducted from the total cost of tuition for the 2024-2025 school year. The enrollment deposit is \$2,250 per student, or 10% of total tuition for families receiving financial assistance (maximum \$2,250).

New Student Registration Fee: For all new students, a one-time registration fee of \$1,500 per student is due by June 1, 2024, not to exceed \$3,000 per family in any one year.

Three Payment Options: Ashley Hall requires families to choose one of the plans listed below for the payment of tuition through Tuition Management, the online payment portal. Tuition Management accepts payment by credit card, electronic check, or paper check.

- **100% Option:** Under this plan, the full payment of tuition is due by June 1, 2024.
- **Two-Payment Option:** A payment of 50% of tuition by June 1, 2024 and the remaining balance by November 1, 2024.
- **Ten-Month Option:** Ten monthly payments of tuition from May 1, 2024 through February 1, 2025.

Please note: There is a late charge if payments are not paid according to the payment option chosen. Payments by credit card incur a convenience fee of 3.12%.

THE TUITION REFUND PLAN *for students in grades Pre-K–12 only*

- The Tuition Refund Plan is not required for any new or returning Early School Pre-Primary or Primary students.
- The Tuition Refund Plan is required for all new and returning families, entering grades Pre-K–12, who select the two-payment or the ten-month plan.
- The Tuition Refund Plan is required for students on any form of probation: financial, academic, or behavioral.
- The Tuition Refund Plan is not required but is optional for any new or returning family entering grades Pre-K–12 who select the 100% payment option.
- The Tuition Refund Plan, if purchased, will be billed separately through Tuition Management.
- The Tuition Refund Plan cost is 2.5% of the total annual tuition.

THE TUITION REFUND PLAN MAY BE ACTIVATED UNDER THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

Medical Absence or Withdrawal:

- **Physical Health Absence or Withdrawal:** 85% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated) will be refunded if the physical health condition or disability extends for 31 or more consecutive days (including weekends and holidays). Refunds are made retroactive to the first day of the illness or disability. The illness must be certified and treated by a licensed physician or surgeon.
- **Mental Health Absence or Withdrawal:** 85% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated) will be refunded if the mental health condition or disability extends for 31 or more consecutive days (including weekends and holidays). Refunds are made retroactive to the first day of the illness/disability. The illness must be certified and treated by a licensed physician or psychiatrist.

Non-Medical Withdrawal:

- A non-medical withdrawal includes, but is not limited to, relocation, change of objective, financial hardship or voluntary withdrawal for any other reason. 75% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated) will be refunded, providing that the student has attended at least 14 days of the academic year (weekends and holidays may be included in this count).

Dismissal:

- 75% of the unused yearly tuition (prorated) will be refunded, providing that the student has attended at least 14 days of the academic year (weekends and holidays may be included in this count).
